FEBRUARY 2006

- *THE ROLLING STONES IN RIO* – The world's largest rock concert, filmed before more than one million fans on the beach at the Copacabana Palace Hotel in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil during the Rolling Stones' *A Bigger Bang* tour.
- *Beastie Boys* – The national premiere of the Beastie Boys "authorized bootleg" concert documentary, *AWESOME: I F*CKIN' SHOT THAT!*, with in-theatre extras including footage from the film's world premiere at the Sundance Film Festival, a personal foreword from the Beastie Boys, as well as exclusive outtakes.

JANUARY 2006
